
Dear Chief, with great joy we want to thank the City of Orange Fire Department for all the attention held to our staff on their visit in October last year.

During 2020 we attended 3014 Fire & Rescue Emergency calls, from which 33.2% were wildland fires. Some of which are in rural areas of our 266 Sq miles response area. We recently opened our Station 6, thanks to the support of the City of Orange Fire Department, being able to reduce the response times for the northern part of the city on a 44%.

It's come to our attention that the Department is upgrading a type 3 fire engine, therefore we would respectfully request to be considered for the donation of the type 3 fire engine that will no longer be in service. This type 3 engine would allow us to provide an adequate response on rural areas and mutual aid to state wide wildland fires.
