WHEREAS, the City agrees to construct Transportation Control Measures projects as noted in the amendments in a timely manner or to assist with finding a substitute project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Orange, does hereby affirm the City's commitment to the projects submitted in the 2027 Federal Transportation Improvement Program.
