

**RESOLUTION NO. 11293**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF ORANGE ACKNOWLEDGING  
RECEIPT OF A REPORT MADE BY THE  
ORANGE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT  
REGARDING PERFORMANCE OF CERTAIN  
REQUIRED ANNUAL INSPECTIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, existing law requires the chief any city or county fire department or district providing fire protection services, and his or her authorized representatives, to inspect every building used as a public or private school within the jurisdiction, for the purpose of enforcing specified building standards, not less than once each year; and

**WHEREAS**, existing law requires every city or county fire department or district providing fire protection services that is required to enforce specified building standards to annually inspect certain structures, including hotels, motels, lodging houses, and apartment houses, for compliance with building standards, as provided; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4 requires every fire department or fire district required to perform such annual inspections to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with conducting those annual inspections.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Orange acknowledges the staff report received from the Orange City Fire Department in compliance with Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4.
