We show this location to be RD 023W, and our current figures show crimes at 94. The average number of reported crimes per district is 74 (crime stats from 2020). This is 20% above the average reported crime.

Evaluation:

Chipotle Mexican Grill will be located at 112 East Maple Avenue in the City of Orange. The site is located on the southwest corner of Maple Avenue and North Orange Street. The location is comprised of .08 acres which includes a 4,276 square foot building with two tenant space. Currently the Pie Hole is located next to the spaces. Chipotle's entry door would face East Maple Avenue.

Valerie Sacks is the Applicant's ABC liquor consultant. Chipotle is proposing indoor/outdoor seating and sale of beer and wine. Chipotle is requesting a Type 41 On-Sale Beer & Wine Eating Place license.

I sent Mrs. Sacks via email the Orange Police Department Conditions for their pending ABC License. Mrs. Sacks told me the Applicant understood the conditions and CUP questionnaire. Mrs. Sacks noted that conditions 18 and 29 relate to hostess/waitress service. Chipotle's business model does not have waitress/hostess service at any of their business locations. Conditions 18 and 29 would not apply to Chipotle's CUP.

Chipotle plans include an outdoor patio area. The patio will consist of four tables, with each table having four seats, for a total seating capacity of 16. The walkway seating on Maple Avenue will consist of six tables, with each table having two seats, for a total seating capacity of 12. The patio area will be designated by landscaping. Mrs. Sacks also stated Chipotle will not allow customers to consume alcohol in their outdoor seating/patio area. She stated if Chipotle were to allow customers to consume alcohol outside, they would have to abide by the conditions for #27 prior to service.

In addition, the applicant states the location will include a "Chipotlane" on Maple Avenue frontage which will be a walkup window accessible on foot only. There will be approximately twelve employees on premises during any given shift. The proposed hours of operation are 9:00 am until 11:00 pm, seven days a week. The applicant owns and operates more than 2,700 restaurants throughout the United States, Canada and overseas.

According to Chipotle's plans, the cooler, containing beer and wine, will be located in the north east portion of the facility. It will be behind the cash register/serving table, in a lockable container. Only the employee will have access to the cooler. The employee working the register/serving table will have a visual of all customers entering and exiting the location.

Concentration Levels:

The census tract figures supplied by ABC show 4 allowed with 24 existing on-sale (over-concentrated) and 2 allowed with 4 existing off-sale (over-concentrated) licenses. BP Code 23958.4 addresses concentration as the number of existing ABC licensed establishments within a given census tract, which is based upon population within each tract.

Crime Statistics and Activity:

The crime statistics for Reporting District 023W shows crimes at 94. The average number of reported crimes per reporting district is 74. Additionally, Reporting District 023W has the 26th highest reported crime rate out of 92 districts in the City of Orange, and is 26% above the average of all reporting districts. Of the 60 total arrests in this reporting district, 16 were alcohol related; 15 for DUI and one for disorderly conduct.

Census Tract / Sensitive Sites:

There are a number of businesses located within close proximity of the establishment. There are no sensitive land issues (i.e., schools) within 500 feet of the location.

Recommendation:

The Police Department does not oppose the applicant's efforts to obtain a Type 41 On-Sale General Eating Place license. Although this area is considered to be over-concentrated and over saturated, approving this application will not be an additional strain on Police resources and services.

CUP CONDITIONS

OPERATIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. ☒ In conjunction with the ongoing operation of the business, the premises shall comply with all requirements placed upon it by the State Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board.
2. ☒ This Conditional Use Permit (CUP) shall be reviewed one year from the date of approval and may be reviewed each year thereafter. The review shall be conducted jointly by the Community Development Director and Police Chief or designees. The purpose of this review shall be to identify uniquely adverse issues such as curfew, loitering, vandalism, criminal activity, noise, or nuisance resulting from approval of the CUP. If such issues are identified, the CUP shall be presented to the Planning Commission for their consideration of conditions, modifications or revocation.
3. ☒ The activity level of the business shall be monitored by the Police Department to establish the level of police services used for the business. Should the level of police services demonstrate that the applicant has not controlled excessive, or unnecessary activity resulting in high use of police services then this Conditional Use Permit shall be reviewed for consideration of further conditions, modifications or revocation.
4. ☒ The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the gross sales of food and meals during the same time period. The licensee shall at all times maintain records which reflect separately the gross sales of food and the gross sales of alcoholic beverages of the licensed business. Records shall be kept no less frequently than on a quarterly basis and shall be made available on request.
5. ☒ The use of the building is considered a restaurant. Interior construction will remain consistent with plans submitted for review by the Planning Commission. No changes to the floor plans will occur unless a permit is issued by the Community Development Department. None of the floor area will be designated for dancing or live entertainment unless a subsequent Conditional Use Permit is approved by the Planning Commission.
6. ☒ No person in the establishment shall appear in such a manner that the genitals, pubic hair, pubic hair region, buttocks, anus, natal cleft, anal region, nipple or areola is exposed to public view or is not covered by an opaque covering.
7. ☒ The subject alcoholic beverage license shall not be exchanged for a public premises type license nor operated as a public premise.

8. ☒ The sale of beer and/or wine for consumption off the premises shall be prohibited.
9. ☒ No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the license.
10. ☒ All alcohol shall be consumed on the subject site. Signs shall be posted on all exits of the premises, which prohibit alcoholic beverages from leaving the confines of the premises.
11. ☒ The premises shall be maintained as a bona fide restaurant and shall provide a menu containing an assortment of foods normally offered in such restaurants.
12. ☒ The hours of operation shall be daily 9:00 am until 11:00 pm. These hours do not restrict employees from being on the premises before opening for preparations and deliveries or after close for clean-up. Clean-up may not be conducted by patrons.
13. ☒ At no time shall there be a fee for entrance/admittance into the premises.
14. ☒ Employees and/or contract security personnel shall not consume any alcoholic beverages prior to or during their work shift. Any and all security officers provided shall comply with all state and local ordinances regulating their services, including, without limitation, Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the California Business and Profession Code.
15. ☒ The applicant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the City, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all liability or claims that may be brought against the City arising out of its approval of this permit, save and except that caused by City's active negligence.

ALCOHOL & FOOD SERVICE CONDITIONS:

16. ☒ At all times when the premises are open for business, the sale and service of alcoholic beverages shall be made only in conjunction with the sale of food.
17. ☒ Food service, with an available menu, shall be available until closing time on each day of operation.
18. ☐ Alcoholic beverages served shall be served by a waiter/waitress only, and only to seated patrons at permitted tables.
19. ☒ There shall be no bar or lounge area upon the licensed premises maintained for the sole purpose of the sale, service, or consumption of alcoholic beverages directly to patrons for consumption.

20. ☒ There shall be no "Happy Hours" when alcoholic beverages are offered at a reduced rate.
21. ☒ There should be no time when alcoholic beverages are sold at a ratio of two for one; no "stacking" of beverages, which means the serving of two alcoholic beverages at one time to the same customer; and no sales to an "empty chair", which means that each customer must be physically present at the time of the order of any alcoholic beverage.
22. ☒ There shall be no promotions encouraging intoxication or drinking contests.
23. ☒ There shall be no requirement to purchase a minimum number of drinks.
24. ☒ No alcoholic beverages shall be sold from any temporary locations on the premises such as ice tubs, barrels, or any other containers.
25. ☒ Alcoholic beverages shall be sold and served in containers, which are distinguishable from other non-alcoholic beverages sold at the premises.
26. ☒ The petitioner shall not employ or permit any persons to solicit or encourage others, directly or indirectly, to buy them drinks in the licensed premises under any commission percentage salary or other profit.

PATIO CONDITIONS:

27. ☒ The patio shall be enclosed and any gates located on the patio shall remain closed during business hours and used as an emergency exit only. Sign(s) shall be posted on all patio gate(s) indicating "Emergency Exit Only".
28. ☒ The petitioner shall not employ or permit any persons to solicit or encourage others, directly or indirectly, to buy them drinks in the licensed premises under any commission percentage salary or other profit.
29. ☐ Patrons on the patio shall be seated by a host/hostess only, with no self-seating permitted.
30. ☒ An employee shall visually monitor the patio at all times to monitor alcohol.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

31. ☒ No portion of the premises shall be deemed to be "private" for the purposes of dispensing alcoholic beverages to selected patrons, where the licensee recognizes

any form of membership cards, keys or passes which would entitle the holder entry or preferential admittance or exclusive use of any portion of the mentioned premises.

- 32. ☒ The use of a promoter (such as a night-club operator) or sub-leasing the premises to be used in conjunction with dancing and/or live entertainment is prohibited.
- 33. ☒ There shall be no live entertainment (including karaoke), disc jockey, amplified music, or dancing permitted on the premises at any time. Amplified music over a built-in system designed for background music shall be permitted so long as the music is not audible outside when doors are open.
- 34. ☒ There shall be no special promotional events held on the property, unless a written request for such is received and approved by the City of Orange Community Development Director and the Police Department's Vice Unit at least one week in advance of the event.

COIN OPERATED MACHINES:

- 35. ☒ There shall be no more than 4 coin-operated games maintained upon the premises at any time.
- 36. ☒ The business may utilize a token coin system to reduce the likelihood of theft and burglaries for U.S. currency in coin operated machines. Should the token system be implemented, the requirements for a burglary alarm system may be waived.
- 37. ☒ All coin change machines, dollar bill change machines, or token machines that accept and retain U.S. currency shall meet the following:
 - A) The machine is to be designed and constructed to be resistant to unauthorized forced entry attempts from any accessible side of the machine.
 - B) The machine is to be installed and secured to prevent its removal from the point of installation within the business.

SECURITY & EXTERIOR:

- 38. ☒ The parking lot of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. If there are any lighting issues the business with immediately notify property management.

39. ☒ Lighting in the parking area of the premises shall be directed, positioned and shielded in such a manner so as not to unreasonably illuminate the window area of nearby residences. If there are any lighting issues the business with immediately notify property management.
40. ☒ The owner shall install and maintain a closed circuit television system capable of readily identifying facial features, and stature of all patrons entering the establishment during hours of operation and monitoring the rear of the premises. The camera system shall keep a minimum 30 day library of events, which shall be available for downloading and inspection by the Orange Police Department.
41. ☒ The use of any amplifying systems, outdoor sound system and paging system or any other such device is prohibited on the licensed premises.
42. ☒ The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which he/she has control.
43. ☒ There shall be no exterior advertising of any kind or type, including advertising directed to the exterior from within, promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages that are clearly visible to the exterior shall constitute a violation of this condition.
44. ☒ Exterior doors and windows, as well as the interior of the business, shall be protected by an approved alarm system, which shall detect an attempted entry or presence of people within the business during closing hours.
45. ☒ Uniformed security will be provided by the applicant on days/nights when special event broadcast(s) are being promoted. One security guard per 100 customers shall be present during these broadcasts/events.
46. ☒ Provide an interior night light to illuminate the interior, and maintain an unobstructed view through storefront windows to provide police patrol officers the ability to observe unlawful activity within the business.
47. ☒ The owner or manager of the licensed premises shall maintain on the premises a written security policy and procedures manual addressing at a minimum the following items: Handling obviously intoxicated persons; establishing a reasonable ratio of employees to patrons, based upon activity level, in order to monitor beverage sales and patron behavior; handling patrons involved in fighting or arguing; handling loitering about the building and in the immediate adjacent area that is owned, leased, rented or used under agreement by the Licensee(s); verifying age/checking identification of patrons; warning patrons of reaching their drinking limit/potential intoxication and refusing to serve; calling the police regarding observed or reported criminal activity.


48. ☒ The applicant shall comply with all federal, state, municipal laws and/or ordinances. Any violations of these laws in connection with this use may be a cause for revocation of this permit.

TRAINING:


49. ☒ All employees of petitioner who sell or serve alcoholic beverage products shall be required to complete a training program in alcoholic beverage compliance, crime prevention techniques and the handling of violence. For new employees of petitioner, such training program must be completed within 30 days of the date of hire. The employees must provide the City of Orange Police Department, Vice Unit, a copy of completed Alcohol Management Program (AMP) certificate.

MISCELLANEOUS:


50. ☐ The business shall prohibit the admission of, or allow any person under the age to 18 years to remain upon the premises after the hour of 10:00 PM, unless accompanied by an adult.
51. ☒ Graffiti shall be removed from the exterior walls and windows of the premises within 72 hours of discovery.
52. ☐ The business shall prohibit the admission of, or allow any person under the age of 18 years to remain upon the premise between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday and Friday, when Orange Unified School District (OUSD) has school in session, unless that person is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. This condition shall apply to all school students, including those who attend schools other than those in OUSD.

Chipotle Mexican Grill (Chipotle Mexican Grill, LLC, d/b/a Chipotle Mexican Grill, ("the Applicant" and/or "Chipotle") is seeking the following discretionary approval:

Pursuant to **Section 17.30.010 of the City of Orange Zoning Code (RSMZC)**, the Applicant requests a **Conditional Use Permit ("CUP")** to allow the sale and/or dispensing of beer and wine for on-site consumption in connection with its forthcoming 60-seat 2,610 s.f. restaurant with hours of operation and alcohol sales from 9 am to 11 pm daily, located on a .08-acre lot in the OTMU-15 zone.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Applicant, Chipotle, is requesting conditional use approval to serve beer and wine pursuant to a type 41 ABC license for on-site consumption at its forthcoming location at 112 E. Maple Avenue in City of Orange ("Site"). Chipotle expects to open summer 2021. The restaurant will be 2,610 s.f. in size and provide 60 seats – 32 seats inside and 28 patio seats -- 16 on-site and 12 on the public right-of-way. The Applicant is not requesting the ability to serve alcohol on the patio.

This location will also include a "Chipotlane" on the Maple Avenue frontage, which will be a walkup window accessible on foot only. This will be adjacent to the 12 patio seats located along the sidewalk between the restaurant and Maple Avenue. In addition, there will be 16 patio seats adjacent to the parking lot. These seats will be buffered by a landscaped area. Patrons will not be able to consume alcohol in either outdoor area but inside the restaurant only.

The Applicant believes that its request for a Conditional Use Permit to serve beer and wine for on-site consumption along with meals at its "fast casual" Mexican-style restaurant is warranted based upon the company's outstanding record of compliance with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverages ("ABC"), the appropriateness of the location for the requested use, and its overall reputation as a well-established, responsible company which can be trusted to manage the requested ABC license appropriately.

THE APPLICANT

The Applicant owns and operates more than 2,700 restaurants throughout the United States, Canada, and overseas, and continues to expand its brand. The Applicant attributes its tremendous growth rate since it opened its first location in 1993 on its vision for its restaurants. The idea is simple: demonstrate that customers could be served good quality food in a distinctive atmosphere--quickly and at an affordable price point. Chipotle uses high-quality raw ingredients, classic cooking methods and distinctive interior design--features that are more frequently found in the world of fine dining. The Applicant essentially established the category of dining now called "fast-casual," the fastest growing segment of the restaurant industry, where customers expect food quality that's more in line with full-service restaurants, but with the simplified menus, speed, and convenience of fast food.

As the company has grown, the Applicant's vision has evolved as well. The Applicant incorporates a concern for the environmental and societal impact of its restaurants into its business model. Features of this model, which the Applicant calls "Food with Integrity," include a commitment to high-quality food, sustainable business practices, charitable giving, and responsible sourcing of animal products. This philosophy is part of an overall commitment to running a business which has a positive impact on its employees, its patrons, its environmentally minded vendors and suppliers, and the communities in which its restaurants are located. Chipotle promotes from within, so that oftentimes employees who start out as line cooks work their way up until they are managing multiple locations. Certainly, practices designed to ensure appropriate training and management practices related to sales of alcoholic beverage products are an important feature of Chipotle's corporate philosophy. Indeed, the Applicant has an outstanding record of compliance with the California ABC and parallel regulatory agencies wherever its restaurants are located.

THE SITE

The subject Site is located on the southwest corner of Maple Avenue and North Orange Street and is comprised of .08 acres. The Site is improved with a 4276 s.f. building comprised of two tenant spaces, including The Pie Hole and the forthcoming Chipotle space, which was most recently occupied by a café. Immediately adjacent to and to the south of the Site along Glassell Street are Woody's Antiques, a "cupcakery," Tokyo Café, and the Pizza Press. Across the street along Glassell, there is a Christian Center, a comic bookstore, and a variety of other restaurant, café, and retail uses. Across the street in a northerly direction, across Maple, are still more restaurants and similar uses, such as The Filling Station Café and Philz Coffee. The Chapman University alumni house is a block to the west along Maple Avenue.

The Site is located within the Historic Core of the City of Orange. Overall, this area can be described as a charming and walkable commercial hub that has a variety of small and/or locally owned establishments. Parking for Chipotle as well as other commercial uses in the vicinity is provided on City-owned surface parking lots, including one containing more than 100 spaces immediately adjacent to the Site. The Site falls under the Downtown Parking Exemption.

The Chipotle space is on the corner but is oriented toward Maple and is adjacent to the existing surface parking lot, which can be entered from Orange Street, the street parallel to Glassell Street and to the east of the Chipotle space. As noted above, Chipotle will be taking over a space formerly occupied by a restaurant/café. As such, there will be no intensification to the Site in terms of parking demand, traffic, or otherwise.

Furthermore, the location, size, design, and operating characteristics of the proposed Conditional Use Permit for the sale of beer and wine at Chipotle's forthcoming restaurant will not create unusual noise, traffic or other conditions or situations that may be objectionable, detrimental, or incompatible with other permitted uses in the vicinity. Chipotle will be located within an existing commercial hub where site access, parking, and other improvements have already been made, and will not be significantly modified as a result of the proposed use.

REQUEST/OPERATIONAL DETAILS

In terms of the request for the within Conditional Use Permit to enable service of beer and wine at its restaurant, Chipotle's experience at its over 2,700 locations worldwide is that its customers appreciate having

the ability to enjoy these items with their meals. The ability to offer these items is an important component of Chipotle's business model and is one of various features that help distinguish it from other casual dining venues. Particularly in light of the impact of Covid-19 on restaurants, the Applicant's ability to offer these items will be an important component ensuring its long-term viability at this location, as will the inclusion of patio dining.

Alcohol consumption will not be permitted on the patio, as certain types of barriers are required by the ABC, and no such barriers will be installed here. In terms of the façade design, signage, landscaping, patio design, and other physical features of the new restaurant, those are being separately reviewed through the City of Orange's Design Review process. Thus, the within request is operational only, and refers only to aspects of the restaurant that pertain to alcohol service.

The Applicant's hours of operation will be 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m. daily. Chipotle requests coterminous hours of alcohol sales. The Applicant believes that the requested hours are modest, and that they are consistent with uses surrounding the Site. The total number of employees at this location will be 25 once it is open for inside dining, with approximately 12 employees on-premises during any given shift. Currently, because of Covid-19 restrictions which mean that all sales are either for take-out or patio dining, its restaurants are more lightly staffed. It is anticipated that such restrictions will no longer be necessary by the time this Chipotle location opens, anticipated to be Fall of 2021.

The Applicant anticipates alcohol sales to comprise only a very small percentage of gross sales at the restaurant. This has been borne out by its experience at other locations. Further, the Applicant recognizes an obligation to be a respectful operator within the community and welcomes input from the Community Development Department and the Orange Police Department. Ultimately, the reputation of the company depends in part on its ability to ensure that all of its locations operate in a manner which is not detrimental to the character of the development of the neighborhoods in which its restaurants are located. Chipotle has established procedures in place at its restaurants to ensure the responsible management of these products. Chipotle as a company is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable experience to its patrons and seeks to operate all of its restaurants in a manner which is consistent with this goal.

In addition, a corporate-managed restaurant such as Chipotle is less likely to have the kinds of problems occasionally associated with alcohol sales in environments that are undercapitalized and/or not professionally managed. Chipotle's staff is trained to recognize and appropriately deal with any problems related to alcoholic beverage sales if they were to arise. The Applicant sets very strict guidelines for the purchase and handling of these items to ensure that the problems sometimes associated with irresponsible management of these products never becomes an issue at any Chipotle location. Examples of such practices include the following:

- 1) Extensive staff training, including specifically alcohol awareness;
- 2) Beer caps are removed at the point of sale to ensure no off-site consumption;
- 3) Alcohol is not sold for off-site consumption with take-out food orders or otherwise at any location ordinarily (some aspects of operations may be modified on a temporary basis as a result of Covid-19);
- 4) Only employees 21 years of age or older open bottles or hand customers drinks, which is stricter than ABC requirements;
- 5) There is always at least one on-site manager over the age of 21 on the premises;

- 6) Chipotle does not offer happy hour;
- 7) Chipotle never serves beer or alcohol in "pitchers";
- 8) Beer is served in bottles, not cups;
- 9) Stores are designed so that employees working the food line or the register can easily see and visually monitor the customer floor area;
- 10) Employees who regularly circulate the store to clean up and bus tables are also tasked with the duty of monitoring customers to ensure that no alcoholic beverages are shared;
- 11) Only one alcoholic beverage per adult customer is served at any one time.

For all of the above reasons, the Applicant respectfully requests the City of Orange's approval of a Conditional Use Permit to enable the sale of beer and wine and outdoor dining, and submits that it is warranted.

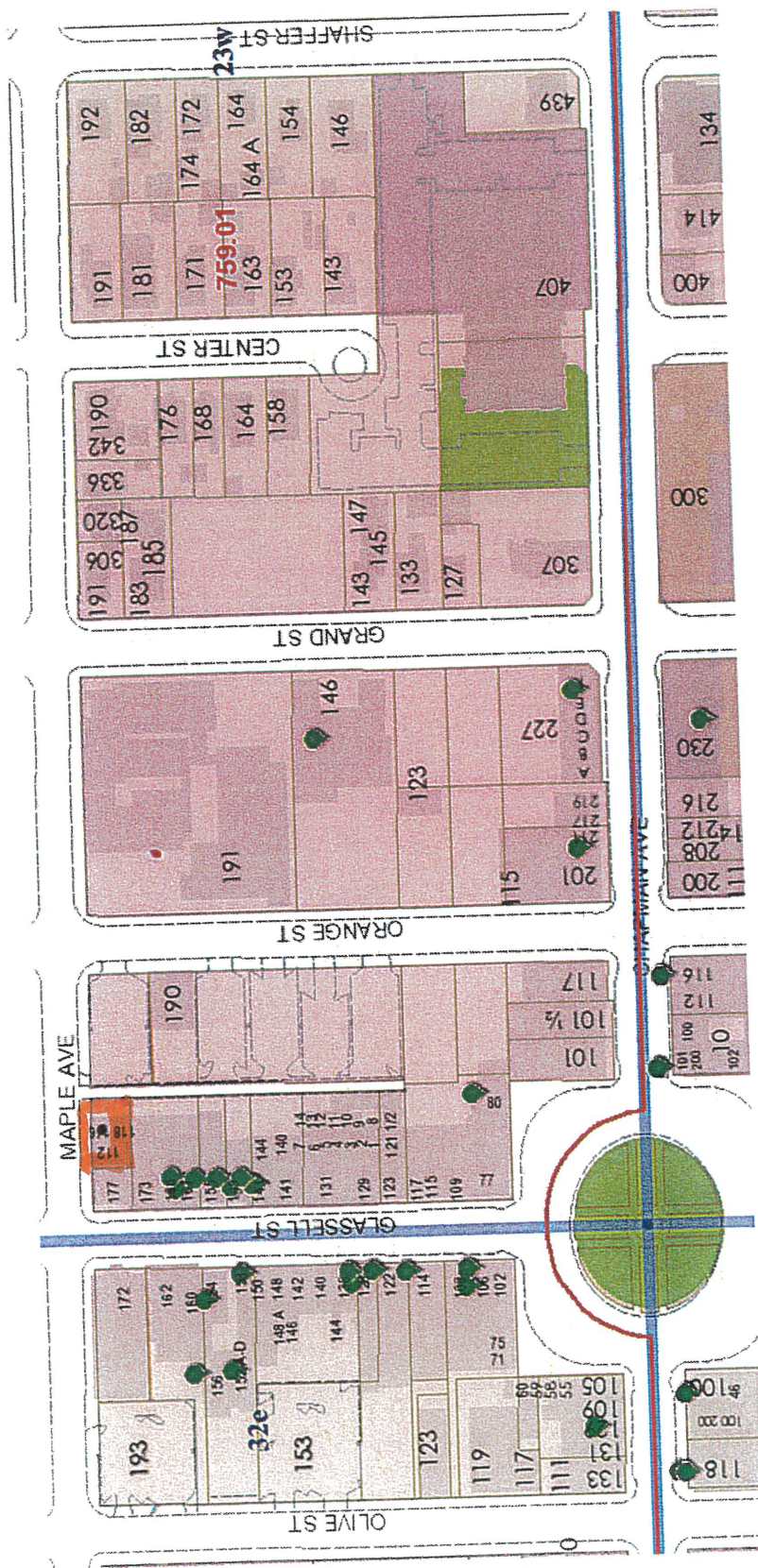
