

**EXCERPT OF DRAFT MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE ORANGE TRAFFIC  
COMMISSION HELD ON APRIL 8, 2026**

**4.1. Request for permit parking on both sides of Olive Street from Almond Avenue to Palmyra Avenue.**

Transportation Analyst Jose A La Torre provided a brief staff report utilizing a PowerPoint Presentation.

Public Speakers

Andy Wile, and Glen Stern spoke in favor.

Devan McLeroy, Vickie Laughlin, Zachary Jones and Andrea Menendez generally support permit parking but expressed concern if permit parking were not expanded to surrounding streets.

Christopher Bui, representing Ricca Donna Salon, spoke in favor but requested the Salon be able to obtain a limited number of permits for employees.

Patrick Calibar provided clarification regarding a duplex address included in the permit area.

Elizabeth Angel raised questions regarding permit allocation and fee structure, particularly as it applies to multi-unit properties.

Responding to Commissioner inquiry, staff clarified a maximum of 5 (five) permits per unit are available.

A motion was made by Chair Feliz, seconded by Commissioner Chavarria, to: 1. Approve the implementation of permit parking along the residential frontages on both sides of Olive Street from Almond Avenue to Palmyra Avenue. 2. Forward to the City Council for final action. The motion carried by the following vote:
